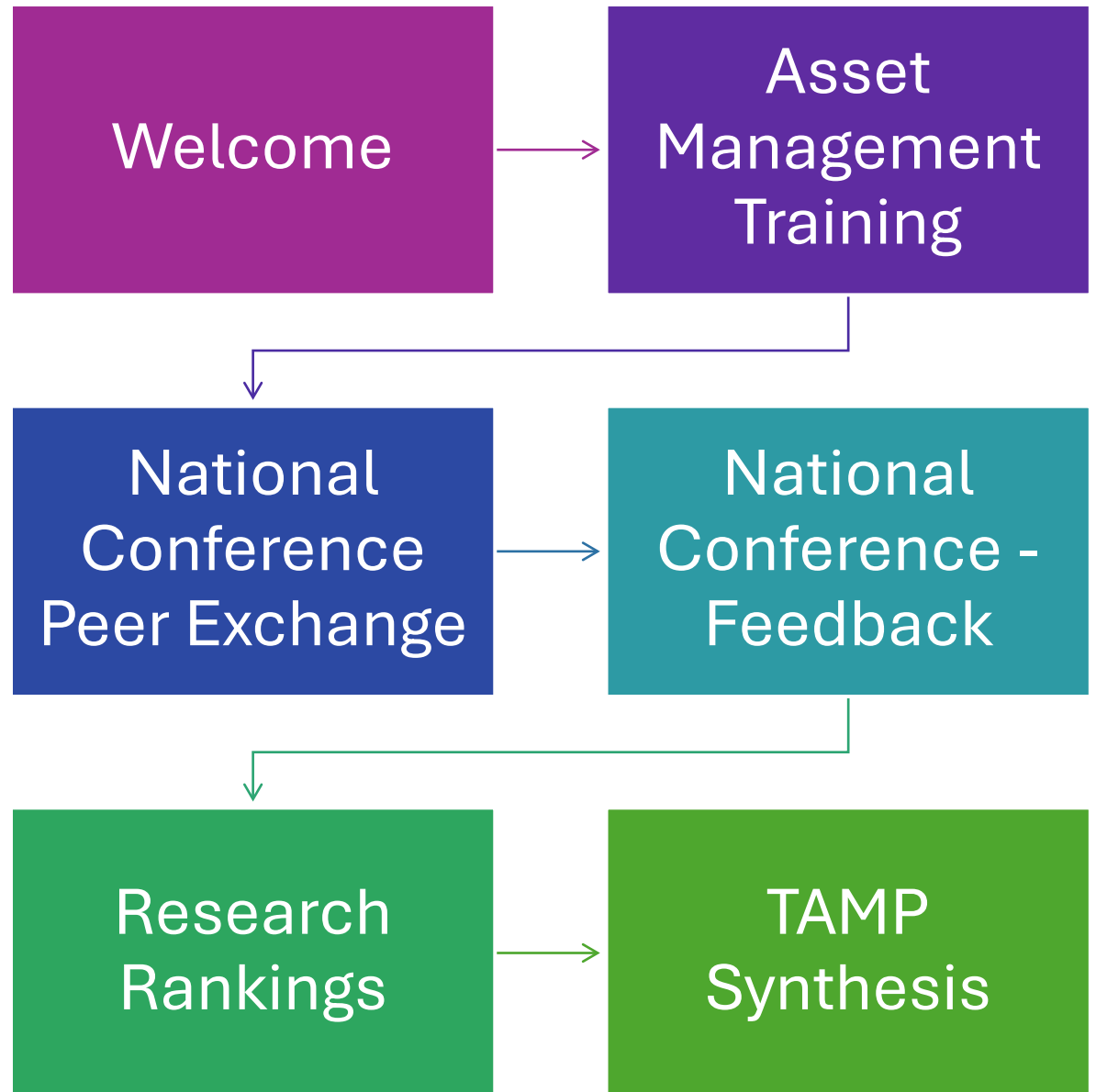

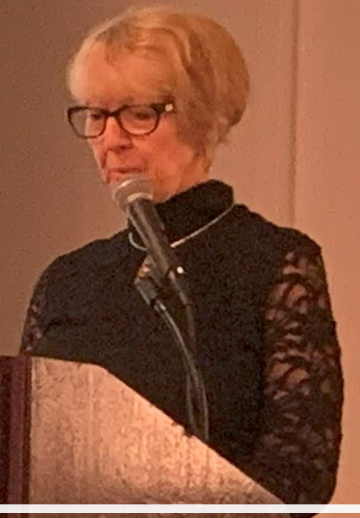

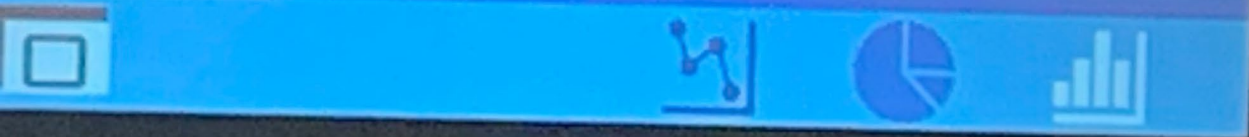

The National Conference is made possible (in part) through a Pooled Fund Research Project.

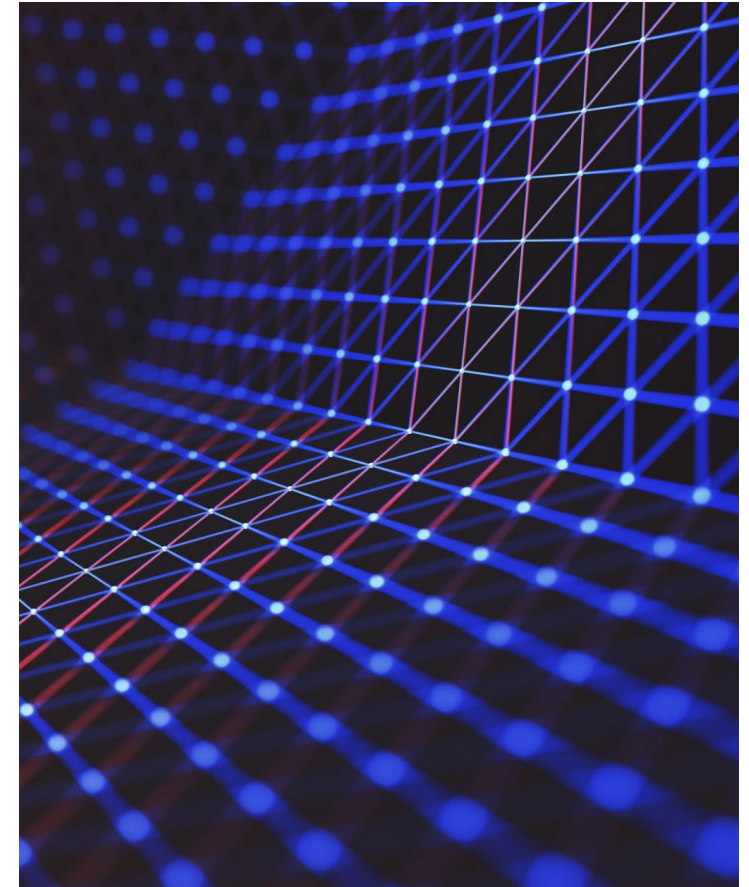
Iowa DOT has led the pooled fund for many years and will not be continuing as lead.

Sub-committee action item to develop a synthesis of states TAMPS.

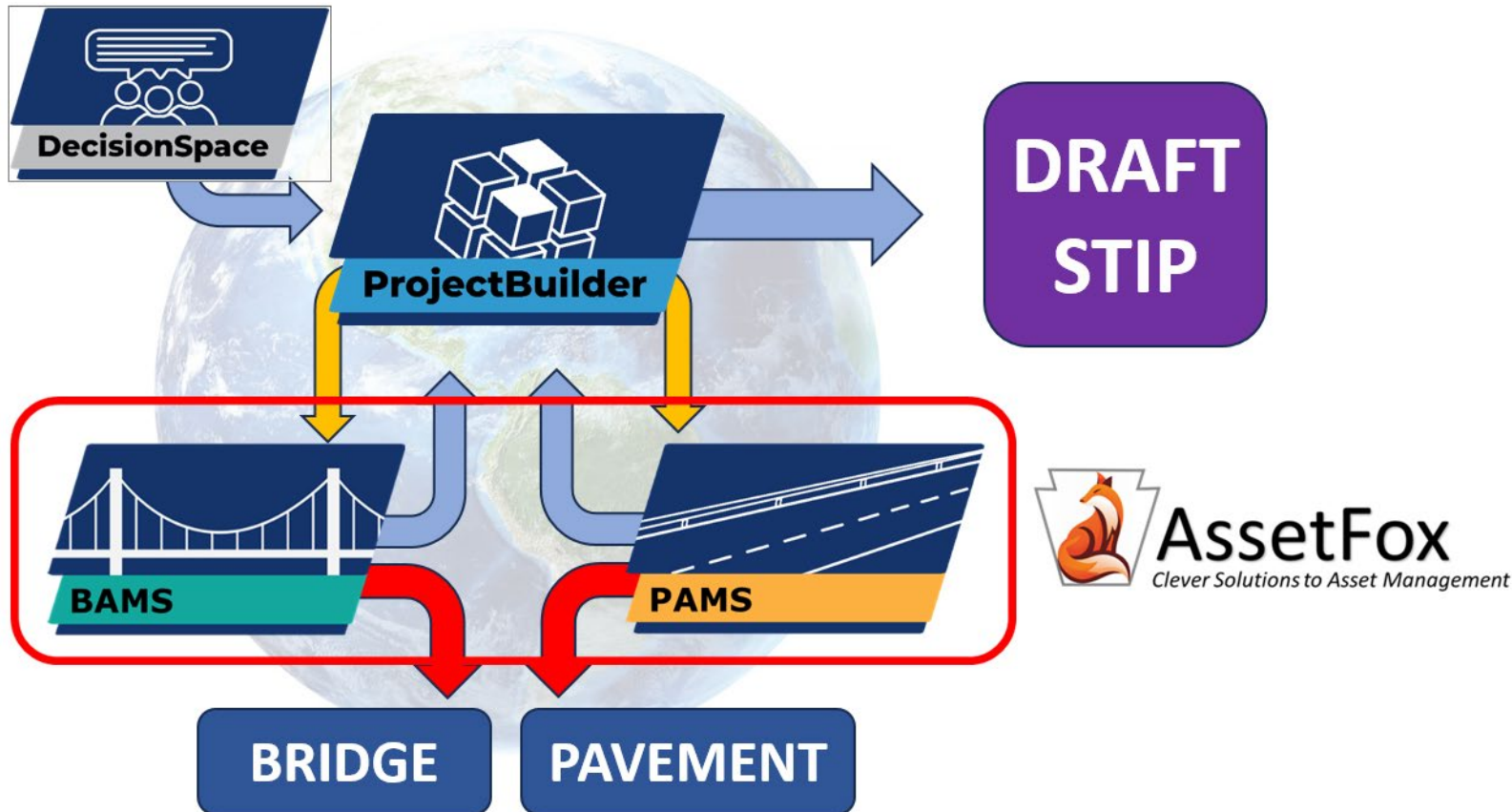
